Raising Awareness

Vehicle crashes are the number one cause of deaths among teens, with the primary collision factor being alcohol. Driving under the influence is dangerous for everyone, especially teenagers.

- In 2023, California had more than 200,000 DUI-related crashes, resulting in more than 280,000 injuries and 4,000 people killed.
- Every day, about 37 people in the United States die in drunk-driving crashes - that's one person every 39 minutes.
- More than a third of teens mistakenly believe they drive better under the influence of marijuana
- The CDC estimated the annual cost of crash deaths involving impaired drivers at \$123.3 billion dollars.

Presentation Details

Conducting a DUI sentencing for local high schools is a two-prong approach of educating teenagers about the legal consequences of drinking and driving as well as the role and decisions of judicial branch of the government. Students will have an opportunity to witness a defendant's hearing and imposed sentence and fines. Following the fine and sentencing the judge will make a brief presentation and co-facilitate the interactive portion of the assembly. The intent is to allow for significant dialogue among the students, defendant, judge, attorneys, law enforcement officers, teachers, and special guest.

To provide a multi-faceted experience for young drivers in order to change attitudes and perceptions about impaired driving. To reduce impaired driving by youth throughout California. The Real DUI Court in Schools Program also encourages informed choices such as avoiding rides with a driver who has been drinking.
